PART A – CHOICE ITEMS

ACTIVITY 1

Listen and match items 1a-5a with photos A-F. One photo (A) is used in the example.

EX. *So, some final things about next week's camping trip. I think everyone is really excited about it!*

01a. *It's very important that you have all the things you will need. I've given you the list, and also a photograph of the things that you will need. Please look at this!*

02a. *When we get to the camping site, you will have to work together to put up your tents.*

03a. *We will be going on some long walks in the mountains, so be ready for this!*

04a. *But it won't all be hard work! You will have time to play sports as well.*

05a. *And of course, there will be times to sit around the campfire and sing songs!*

Listen again and check your answers.

ACTIVITY 2

Listen to items 6a-8a and choose the best answer (A to D). There is one answer you do not need.

06a. *Hi mum, it's me – I've got basketball practice after school, so you don't need to come and get me; I'll walk home...*

07a. *Hi, when you get home, could you look for my blue sports bag? I think I left it on my bed.*

08a. *Me again. I'm going to be really late, so I won't have time to take Scotty for his walk. Sorry! Can you do it? His ball is in the cupboard.*

ACTIVITY 3

Listen and choose the best answer (A, B, or C) for items 9a-10a.

9a. Dialogue 1

A: So, what shall we get Robbie for his birthday?

B: I think he wants a new phone.

A: Hmm... But his phone is only a year old!

B: Yes, I know. He wants the same one his friend has.

A: I really don't agree with that! Let's think of something else.

10a. Dialogue 2

A: *Maggie, how was your holiday?*

B: *OK, not bad...*

A: *Why? I thought you were going to Paris – in the spring!*

B: *Yes, we did. But the hotel was really not so good, and very far from the centre. And the room was very small, and very expensive.*

ACTIVITY 1

Listen and fill in gaps 1b-5b with the right word, as in the example.

EX. *Right, is a basic one OK, for general maths? Or do you need a scientific one?*

01b. *How many do you need – about 6? What colours – blue, black – do you need red ones?*

02b. *Do the teachers give you one for each lesson? Do you have to take them all to school every day?*

03b. *Do you need such a big one? It will be really heavy to carry. .*

04b. *Do you need special ones for sports? Or can you wear the ones you walk to school in?*

05b. *You must get one for your water – you can fill it up at school during the day, right?*

ACTIVITY 2

Listen and fill in gaps 6b-10b with the right word, as in the example.

EX: *We always make our own – it's really easy, you just need to make the base, and then the tomato sauce, the cheese, and then you can add salami, ham, whatever you want.*

06b. *There isn't a bakery in the village, so we bake our own every morning. It's not difficult, you just need flour, water and yeast. And it smells wonderful. It's great to eat it fresh for breakfast, with marmalade or cheese.*

07b. *We make this every dinner time. My favourite is with just tomatoes and cucumber, but I also make a great one with carrots, cabbage and green peppers.*

08b. *We never buy those ready squeezed ones in bottles from the supermarket, we always make our own from fresh fruits. We often use just oranges, but we also make a mix with lots of fruits like orange, carrot, apple and pineapple.*

09b. *We always make our own – the ones you buy are much too sweet. The kids always want a chocolate one for their birthday, and last year I made a dinosaur one for my son's party, with special candles.*

10b. *I love making cheese ones, but my husband makes great ones with spinach and also meat. Much better than the ones at the bakery!*
