ACTIVITY 1

Listen to items 1a-4a and choose the best option (A-F), as in the example (D). There is one option you do not need.

EX: I've just re-read this wonderful classic of 19th century life in rural England, set in the forests and countryside.

- 1a. But I also really enjoy adventure stories, and this one is an incredible tale of one man's battle with the elements as he tried to conquer one of the world's highest peaks.
- 2a. This was another story of survival. This time of the terrible conditions encountered by soldiers as they struggle through the harsh, frozen landscape on their way to the battle.
- 3a. I read this book with my grandson – it's a lovely story of the relationship between a boy and an old man during wartime England.
- 4a. I didn't read this with my grandson – it would have given him nightmares! More tales of the dangerous elements! The cover of the book is brilliant, creating huge suspense even before you open the pages.
